### **Subject offered in the College**

- Range of Core /Elective options offered by the University and those opted by the college :
  - ◆ **Core Compulsory Special Subjects:**  
(B.A/B.Com and M.A/M.Com.)  
Four Subjects are offered as special subjects: English, Sanskrit, Gujarati and Accountancy are available to students as Core Compulsory / Special Subjects.
  - ◆ **Core Elective Subjects:**  
Sanskrit, Gujarati, Hindi, Sociology, Indian Constitution, Personality Development and Sports, Secretarial Practice, Statistics, Computer, Tally, Environment and Disaster Management, Industrial Entrepreneurship, General Knowledge.

- ◆ **Choice Based Credit System and range of subject options:**  
The CBCS System has been implemented since 2011-12 with wide range of Subjects (as mentioned above) options are available to students.
  - ◆ **Courses offered in modular form:**  
B.A/B.Com. SEM-I, II, III, IV, V, VI  
M.A/M.Com. SEM-I, II, III, IV  
All Courses are divided into units.
  - ◆ **Credit transfer and accumulation facility:**  
Credit Transfer and accumulation facility is not yet implemented in our State / University. It is under Consideration.
  - ◆ **Lateral and vertical mobility within and across programmes and courses:**  
It exists we have lateral mobility in Subjects like Sanskrit, Gujarati and English. In Commerce Lateral Mobility is available only in Elective Subjects.
  - ◆ **Enrichment courses:**
    - We offer certificate of English Proficiency Test conducted by SCOPE (Short-term)
    - We offer Basic Computer Courses.(Short-term)

Ours is a Grant in Aid College and the fees are moderate except self-finance UG Course in English. The S.C., S.T., E.B.C., Baxi Panch Students receive scholarships as per the UGC and State Government norms. Girls are exempted from tuition fees. Our College and management felicitates and gives a momentum for the top three Rank Holders in all the subjects in all the classes.

### **Student Support Services:**

**(For the socially / physically and economically deprived students)**

- 1. Special Consideration for Students of Reserved Category:**  
Students from SC/ST, OBC and belonging to various sections economically weaker sections are guided and encouraged to apply for scholarships as per the State Government, Central Government norms. Special facilities are given in the Library (Example: Book Bank Facility) to such students.
- 2. Physically Disabled Students:**  
Students with physical disabilities are natural provided special care and attention by the college. Proper attention and care is taken of such students at the time of admission and henceforth. During

examination separate sitting arrangement is made on the ground floor for their convenience. Apart from moral support and sympathy, financial support is extended to them by the Government. Such students receive Rs.2500/- per year at UG Level Course and Rs.5000/- per year at PG Level Course as Government Scholarship.

3. **Overseas Students:** As the college is located at remote area and as there are no overseas students, no specific services or facility is offered to them.
4. **Concessions:** Students are provided financial assistance in the form and of concession to participate in various competitions held by the University or other events.
5. **Concession for Students of Sports:** Concession of travel for participation in University or College Tournaments for the Students of sports is facilitated from the college.
6. **Medical Assistance for the Students:** A General Accidental Insurance is covered for all the students under the Govt. of Gujarat initiative. Moreover, there is a health unit in the college which offers First Aid Treatment and medical support to the students on casualties. Moreover, the college has a tie up with Dr.Navinbhai Thakkar, a M.B.B.S. Doctor and Honorary Secretary of the Management who offers his services in emergencies at college and at his Private Hospital too. Body check up and Thallesemia test is arranged for the students every year.
7. **Coaching Classes for Competitive Exams:** UGC sponsored special coaching classes such as Entry-in-Service Classes, Career Advancement Lectures, Quiz on General Knowledge; Environment Awareness etc. are arranged for the students to face competitive exams. Moreover, the students are also encouraged to appear in the General Knowledge Test conducted by Gardi Chair, one of the University wings that works for the students career development.
8. **Skill Development:** The College functions skill oriented programmes like Basic Computer Course, Functional English Course etc. the College also trains the students for English Proficiency Test conducted by SCOPE. Moreover, the students are

also exposed to debates like Elocution Competition, Literary Quizzes, Paper Presentations in the Class-room to develop oratory skills among them.

- 9. Support for “Slow Learners”:** In order to Support “Slow Learners”. The College conducts “Remedial Coaching Classes” ‘Bridge Course’ and Functional English Class in order to support the slow learners to enable them to be in place with the main stream and advanced learners. Moreover, personal guidance and coaching is imparted to them along with written materials. Class Tests are conducted to improve their learning ability. Faculty make necessary suggestions to slow learners after the Internal and University exams. Teachers encourage them for better performance in future.
- 10. Exposure for the Students to other institution:** The College ensures field trips or visits to various institutions for the students to enable them to give practical view of organizations. The College during the last year has arranged various visits like visit to Kandla Port, Cotton Spinning Industries in and around Radhanpur, Solar Plant and Salt Industry etc.
- 11. College Souvenirs:** There is no publication of student magazine in the institution. However, the students are motivated to contribute their articles, views, literary creations in our college souvenirs and wall-paper displays. The Institution thinks positively to initiate the publication of student magazine in the future. However, the students can express their views and creations in the students corner of the wall presentation.
- 12. Group Insurance:** The College facilitates the students with insurance coverage. Two insurance coverage is offered to all the students enrolled in the college. One Insurance coverage is offered by the Government of Gujarat under Veer Kinari wala which covers Rs. One lac for accidental death. Another insurance of United India Co. Ltd. is offered to the students which covers Rs. 60,000/- on Accidental Death and Rs.10,000/- as accidental hospitalization coverage.

**13. Motivating incentive for meritorious students:** The College felicitates the top three rankers and honours them with shields. Moreover, Distinction and First Class holders also felicitated with motivating incentives from the Management and the College.
